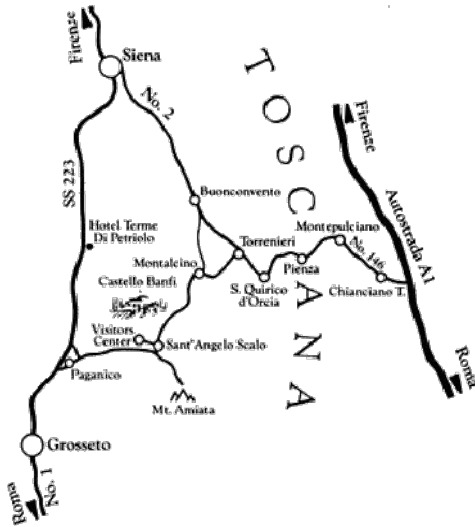




Directions to Castello Banfi

Located in Sant' Angelo Scalo (Montalcino)-just 35 miles south of Siena, and 125 miles north of Rome- Castello Banfi lies in some of Italy's most dramatic and panoramic countryside. Year-round travelers are welcome to explore the estate's many offerings. Guided tours of the estate by appointment.



From Florence (or Firenze); the total estimated driving time is 2 hours and 5 minutes:

From downtown Firenze follow the blue signs indicating Siena. After leaving the city of Firenze you will drive for approximately 2 km before reaching a large roundabout (driving time approx: 15 min). Take the second exit from the roundabout which will take you directly to the highway that takes you to Siena. You will see the blue sign to Siena again indicating 56 km/35 miles (driving time: approx 45 min).

You will see exits for Siena nord, Acqua Calda, Siena Ovest and finally Siena Sud. Stay on the main route and proceed toward Grosseto (blue sign). After 50 km/31 miles of this road (please be extremely careful passing other vehicles) you will reach the exit for Paganico (driving time: approx 45 min). Exit at Paganico and immediately turn left following the signs for Monte Amiata.

At the first stop sign turn right and then take the second turn on the left. Follow the brown signs for Monte Amiata and the blue signs for Montalcino. Follow the road for 13.5 km/8.5 miles then turn left toward Montalcino. You'll drive over a small creek bridge, then a railroad track then after 200 meters you'll the signs on your left for Castello Banfi. After about 3 km/2 miles you'll see the Castello on your left (driving time approx 20 min). Welcome!
