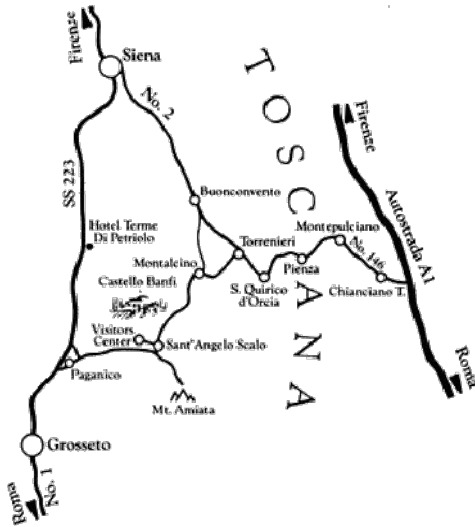




## Directions to Castello Banfi

*Located in Sant' Angelo Scalo (Montalcino)-just 35 miles south of Siena, and 125 miles north of Rome- Castello Banfi lies in some of Italy's most dramatic and panoramic countryside. Year-round travelers are welcome to explore the estate's many offerings. Guided tours of the estate by appointment.*



From Roma; the total estimated driving time is 3 hours:

If your hotel is in downtown Roma we suggest you find your way to Via Salaria (near Villa Borghese) and follow it for approximately 20 km/13 miles (15 minutes with no traffic) until you reach the Autostrada (green sign - direction Firenze). You will reach the toll booth after approximately 15 km and after 128 km/80 miles you'll see the exit for Chiusi-Chianciano (driving time: approx 1 hr and 15 min). Exit at Chiusi-Chianciano and follow the signs for Chianciano Terme.

Stay on the main road until you see signs for Montepulciano. At the foot of Montepulciano (up to the right) keep following the main road toward Pienza (veers left). You'll drive for 15 km/9.5 miles before reaching Pienza then after 8 km/5 miles you'll reach San Quirico d'Orcia (driving time: approx 50 min).

Once you reach San Quirico d'Orcia, follow the blue signs toward Siena (north) and/or SS2 Cassia-Siena. Once you're on Via Cassia take the first exit for Montalcino. You should reach the village in approximately 15 minutes. At the second roundabout (right next to the Fortress) take the third exit following the indications for Grosseto - San Angelo - Paganico. Stay on this road until you arrive at San Angelo Scalo (big white sign). Immediately turn right. After 3 km/2 miles you will see Castello Banfi on your left (driving time: approx 20 min). Welcome!
